General

1. What is the website?

Our website is https://accel-golf.com. Here, you can learn about the app, find helpful information and access the StatCard

2. How do I get to the web app?

In your browser, go to https://app.accel-golf.com. This is the exact same as the mobile app

3. Where do I download the mobile app?

Search for Accel Golf on the Apple App Store or Google Play Store

4. What is Accel Golf?

Accel Golf is a mobile and web app that tracks golf statistics. Additionally, you can use Accel Golf as a diary to track practice sessions, drills, lesson notes, workout exercises and more. Accel Golf keeps all your golf information neatly organized and provides powerful insights to help you improve your game.

The StatCard

1. How do I get the StatCard?

The Accel Golf StatCard is free to download at https://accel-golf.com/statcard or by clicking on the StatCard link in the side menu of the app.


How should I print the StatCard?

The StatCard can be printed on regular paper in black and white or color. Ideally, you can print it double sided, but two pieces of paper works too!

Can I fold the StatCard?

Yes! We recommend folding it into thirds along the red dotted lines below. And then folding it in half on the blue dotted line





Scanning the StatCard

1. Why is my scan not working?

If you get an error message, try these tips to correct the scan:

- Flatten the paper as much as possible, and line up the tables
- Make sure the entire paper is visible. Do not cover any part of the paper
- Avoid shadows; best when it's not a single light above the paper. Doing it outside usually works well with lighting
- Make sure the bold black lines are visible. If you folded on the line and it's faded, color over it with a black pen/sharpie/pencil
- Good network connection helps
- A dark background also helps
- You can copy the writing onto a fresh piece of paper and then scan that one.

If the errors persist despite all these corrections, you can manually enter the round by clicking the right arrow. You will then just have to add each hole and shot by clicking and typing.

2. Can I scan on my computer?

No, unfortunately scanning can only be done on phones and tablets.



Statistics

1. How many players can a coach put in a multi-player report?

As many as they want, but only 6 will fit per page. Accel Golf will automatically break it down into groups of 6 or fewer players. If you want a certain 6 players on the same page, select just those 6 players.

2. What does OGP mean?

On Green Percentage. Regardless of if the shot was for a GIR or not, just if that shot got onto the green.

3. How do I move events to different folders?

Click into the event and press the add to folder button. Then navigate and choose from the folders.

4. Can I put folders inside of other folders?

Yes, you can select the folder by clicking the folder icon to highlight it. Then click the edit button in the top right and choose where you want to move the folder.

5. If person "A" is shared on the folder and I put an event inside the folder, will they see it?

Yes, if you want them to not be able to see it, then you can manually remove them from being shared on that event.

6. What counts as short/mid/long putts?

Short is 10 feet and under. Mid-range is 10-20 feet. Long is over 20 feet.

7. What counts as short/mid/long approach shots?

Short is 30-100 yards. Mid-range is 100-150 yards. Long is over 150 yards.

8. What counts as a chip/pitch

Anything inside 30 yards of the green.



Calendar

1. Why would an event not show up in the calendar?

An event will not show up if it is not shared properly.

Drills

1. Can I see drill results over time?

Not yet.

2. Can I use a picture or video as the drill description?

Not yet.

3. Can I add my own drills?

Yes. See the player or coach guide to learn how.

4. Why can't my players see the drills I created?

Make sure you share the drill with them. In the drill click "Add a User" or "Add a Team"
